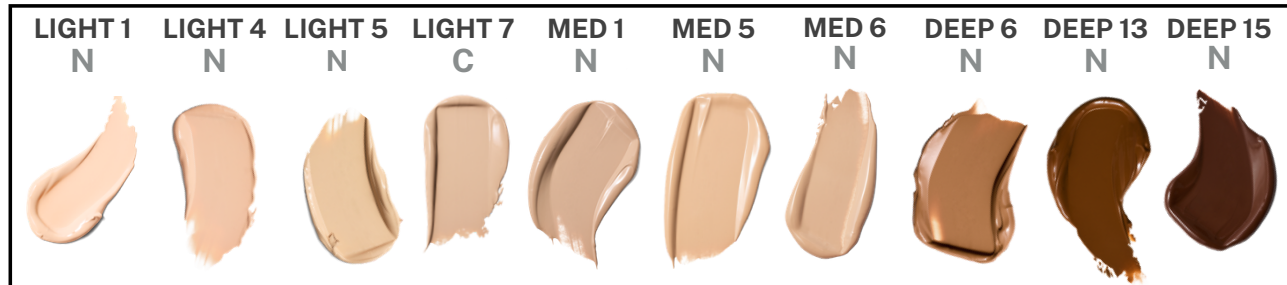

This chart is to help guide you in finding your correct undertone in the TimeWise® 3D Foundations. After you find your undertone, use the boxes below to identify your best shade.

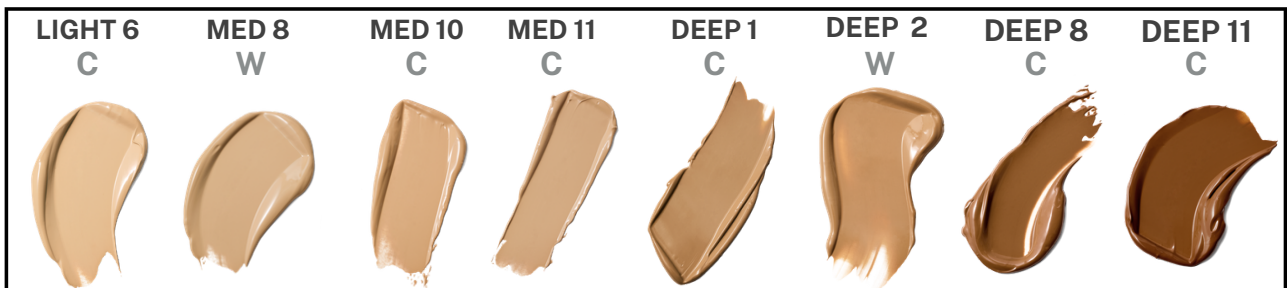
NEUTRAL UNDERTONES

Balanced Skin,
not pulling pink
or yellow.



OLIVE UNDERTONES

Subtle green or
gray cast of the
skin. Traditional
“warm”
foundations often
pull orange.



GOLDEN UNDERTONES

Natural warmth,
appears honey-
colored, and skin
tans well.

shade.**

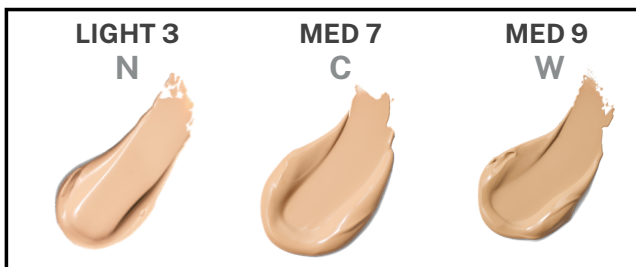
N = Neutral Undertone

C = Cool Undertone

W = Warm Undertone

YELLOW UNDERTONES

Usually a warm
undertone, gold
jewelry looks best.



**Steps To Finding Your Foundation
Shade:**

1. Match Depth

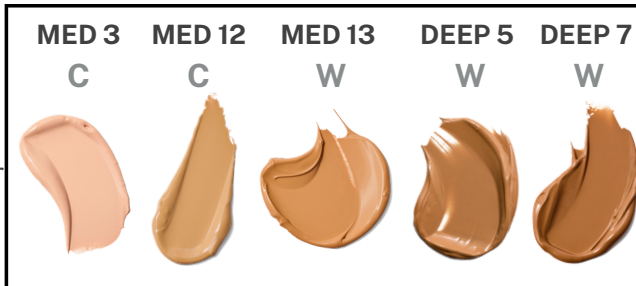


**2. Swipe 2–3 shades along the
jawline and choose the one that
disappears into the skin.**

**3. It's normal to wear different
foundation shades throughout
the year based on season and
sun exposure.**

PEACHY UNDERTONES

Peach undertone
means your skin
pulls red, orange, or
pink color on the
skin.



ROSY UNDERTONES

Sometimes has
redness in the
skin and silver
jewelry looks
best.
